Each speaker will have up to three minutes to speak at the discretion of the Chair. Your information may be received and discussed or placed on a future agenda. State law generally precludes the Council from discussing or acting upon any topic presented during Public Comment that is not on the meeting's published agenda. Note: There is a time limit of 30 minutes for public comment. Each speaker will be heard in the order of submission of a Speaker Slip. All above times are approximate and subject to change.
